## Minutes of Meeting on 26/10/2014

Minutes of State Medical Council Meeting was held on 26/10/2014 at the Conference Hall of R.F.P.T.C. Uttarakhand, 107, Chander Nagar, Dehradun at 2:00 pm., following were present.

Dr. R.N.Singh opened discussion on ("Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) regulations 2002" in I.M.C. Act 1956. Matters in the regulation were discussed and deliberated upon, it was decided that issues be propogated between persons who are required to follow the regulation.

The Registrar detailed the members about the progress made in pending cases of High Court Uttarakhand.

Registrar also apprised the members about request made by him to all medical colleges through letters to get their faculty members registered with U.K.M.C.

Registrar also stressed upon the council members to allow appointment of a consultant at council who could help in solving the legal regulatory problems which are increasing with time. It was agreed upon on suggestion of Dr. R.N. Singh and Dr. D.D. Chaudhary that a request be made to Shri S.K. Majumdar if he is willing to share burden of legal work as consultant at Council on a token payment of **Rs 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand)** each month honorarium consultancy charges. The registrar was given an open hand to proceed in the matter of the agreement on consultancy matures.

The discussions also included raising of honorarium payment to members coming to attend meeting form outside Dehradun. It was decided that members from Haridwar and H.I.M.S. Jolly Grant be paid **Rs 2500/-** and members form Srinagar (Garhwal), Haldwani and Rudrapur be paid **Rs 4000/-.**
